## o Mental Health Wellness

• We have been focusing on student wellness as well as workplace wellness. We are doing what we can to support everyone by having our school counselor work with classes on lessons such as, "how to be a good friend", or "how to deal with someone not liking me." The older grades are working on things such as anxiety related to test taking, or executive functioning, like, "how do I keep my locker clean?".

## o Nutrition Nook – Food Security

 Continues to be a challenge. Every week we see an increase in the kids that need lunches. We receive lunches from the rotary club but it is not enough. We receive 15 lunches on Monday and Wednesdays, so we are trying to find a way to get volunteers to make extra sandwiches.

#### o Christmas Concert & Aladdin (The Musical)

- The date for the concert will be Tuesday, Dec 19<sup>th</sup> and we will have two performances. The afternoon performance will start at 1:00 pm and then the evening performance will be at 7:00 pm. Ms. Nesbitt and Mr. MacDonald will be sharing this responsibility and are excited to move forward with this. Next meeting, we can talk about some of the fundraising activities the council would like to do during the concert.
- **Aladdin** will be our musical this year. Kids will start auditions later in November and the dates for the performances will be May 29<sup>th</sup> and May 30<sup>th</sup>.
